



POST-GRADUATE PROGRAMS

Overview - A rigorous one-year training program for self-directed and motivated students.

Joseph P. Keefe Technical School offers rigorous technical training to recent high school graduates who are looking to further their education in a technical training program.

Post-Graduates are admitted to Keefe Technical School on a space-available basis. Post-Graduate are students who have recently graduated from high school or have earned a high school equivalency certificate. Students enrolled in a Post-Graduate Program at Keefe Technical School may earn a program certificate or the Certificate of Occupational Proficiency, provided they receive passing scores on required exams and competency tests and satisfy attendance requirements.

Post-Graduate Technical Training is completed over a ten-month period from September-June. Adult programs consist of 1000 hours of technical training taking place in the same labs, training areas, and classrooms as the high school population. Adult students spend every week, Monday-Friday from 7:30 AM to 2:00 PM in technical training.

Present diploma or equivalency certificate or current transcript if you have not completed HS.

Required after acceptance: Proof of immunizations: two doses of MMR and a current Tetanus shot. The Hepatitis B series will also be necessary and must be started within 30 days of enrollment, if needed.

Due upon acceptance: A non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 is due upon enrollment. The total cost of the ten-month program is \$500.00. Payments of \$50.00 are due at the first of each month. Additional costs for equipment may also be required in some programs.
